### **Human Swine Influenza**

Public Health Agency of Canada Message for International Travellers  
Arriving In Canada  
On Board Announcement

#### **Announce prior to taking off**

During your time outside Canada, you may have travelled through a Human Swine Influenza-affected area.

If you currently have a fever and a cough or develop these symptoms during the flight – notify one of the airline crew immediately.

Not all travellers with influenza symptoms, such as fever and cough, will have human swine influenza. However, it is important to ensure that if you do experience these symptoms, you follow the recommendations described below. These actions are very important for stopping the spread of human swine influenza.

#### **Announce just prior to landing**

Please be aware that if you have a fever and a cough – you are required by law to report this to a Canadian Border Service Officer (CBSA) during the customs process.

If you are currently feeling well but you develop a fever and a cough over the next 7 days, the Public Health Agency of Canada recommends that you seek medical attention as soon as possible. It is very important to immediately inform a health care provider of your recent travel history, along with your symptoms.

Not all travellers with these symptoms have developed Human Swine Influenza. It is nevertheless important to ensure that if you do experience these symptoms, you avoid contact with people until you have been assessed by a health care provider. These actions are very important for stopping the spread of Human Swine Influenza.
