The Glenrose Rehabilitation Hospital is one of the largest freestanding comprehensive tertiary rehabilitation centers in North America and offers services to children and adults on an inpatient, outpatient, day patient and outreach basis. The Paediatric Rehab Division (PRD) serves over 2000 children and families a year through more than 25 programs and services. The vision of the PRD is “to enhance the independence and quality of life of children with or at risk of complex disabilities and their families by providing tertiary (re)habilitation within the continuum of comprehensive care”. A core value of the Division is Family—Centered Care.
