Second Hand Baby equipment

Many people may offer to share their baby items. Some of these things may be helpful, but others may be dangerous for your baby. How can you tell the difference? All boxes must be checked off below in order for an item to be safe.



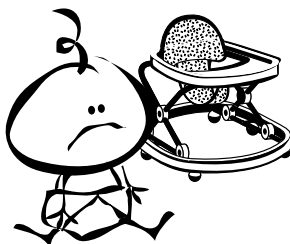
Cribs

- This crib was made after 1987.
- This crib mattress fits tight against all four sides of the crib.
- The mattress is firm, not soft.
- The side of the crib locks into place when it is up.
- The bottom of the crib where the mattress lies, is bolted into place. No hooks are used.

Child Safety Seats

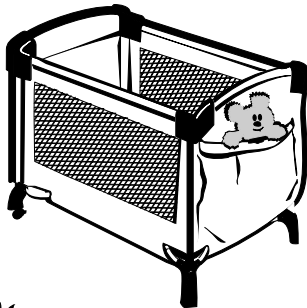


- This child safety seat is less than 10 years old.
- Instructions are available for the seat and I have checked that all parts are still here and the seat is being used correctly.
- There are no broken parts on the seat, and I do not see any bending, cracks or other signs of damage.
- The child seat has never been in a car crash.
- I know where to go to have this child seat checked out.



Walkers

- This walker does not have wheels. Many babies have been injured in those types.



Playpens

- This playpen does not have more than two wheels.
- The mesh sides of the play pen have very small holes only so the baby can not become trapped in them.
- There are no tears in the plastic sides or the top of the playpen.
- There are no tears in the mattress. (Babies can choke on little pieces of plastic).
